PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Learn to Skate Hockey 1, 2, 3 & 4

Forward and backward skating techniques, hockey stops, crossovers, transitions between forward and backward. Prerequisite is Snowplow Sam or Basic 1 in Pineville's Learn to Skate program, or the skater should have proficient balance and forward skating skills. Skates are provided. A helmet is required, and hockey gloves are recommended. Completion of all four levels is NOT required to advance to Learn to Play.

Learn to Play Hockey

Players learn hockey fundamentals to prepare them for game play: skating skills, stick handling, passing and shooting. Game fundamentals and rules are introduced. Full gear is required. Learn to Play is a prerequisite for House League.

Intermediate House League

Recommended for ages 5 to 10 or for older youth players that are just starting. The Intermediate League emphasizes skating and hockey skill development, game knowledge, basic strategy and fun. Players are grouped in practice and in games according to experience and ability. Most games will follow a cross-ice format to increase puck touches and accelerate skill development. Full ice games are introduced late in the season. This league is NON-CHECKING. However, use of the body to gain positional advantage and puck possession is introduced. Full gear and USA Hockey Registration are required.

Advanced House League

Recommended for ages 10 to 14 or for younger players with advanced skills. The Advanced League continues skating and skills development while teaching game fundamentals, positional play and strategies in full ice games. This league is NON-CHECKING. However, use of the body - including angling, pinching, shoulder to shoulder and incidental contact - to gain positional advantage and puck possession is taught and allowed to prepare players for future play in checking leagues. Full gear and USA Hockey Registration are required.

Pineville Travel Hockey

The Pineville Falcons field travel teams at Squirt, Peewee, Bantam and Midget levels. These teams compete in the Carolinas Hockey League as well as in USA Hockey sanctioned tournaments primarily in the East and Southeast. Falcons practices and home games are held at the Pineville Ice House. Tryouts are held in the summer preceding the September to March season.
