Learn to Skate SPRING 2010

- * **8 week class in the Learn to Skate program, Mondays or Saturdays**
- * **One hour class, divided into four 15 minute primary focuses**
- * **Four skating levels from Free Skate 1 to USFS No Test & up**
- * **Cost: \$120 for 8 lessons (+ \$15 late fee for enrollments after deadline) + \$13 for USFS Basic Skills membership (July 1, 2009-June 30, 2010) \$17 for one walk-on try-it lesson (in first 3 weeks and space permitting)**
- * **All skating school benefits apply (See Learn to Skate brochure)**

In this class, skaters in each skating level group spend 15 minutes learning about each of the 4 primary skating focuses. Every 15 minutes, the students move to another instructor and area on the ice for the next skating focus.

The students in Basic Skills Program levels Free Skate 1 through Free Skate 6 focus on 2 or 3 elements at a time, covering all of the required elements in their curriculum in the 4 focuses. The primary focuses for students at the USFS No Test or higher level cover spins, footwork and moves, artistry, and jumps.
